FUBiS is an intensive, academic program through which students can earn credits that may be counted towards their degrees at their home institutions. FUBiS sessions run for 4 to 6 weeks and take place both in summer and winter.

Dates for Summer 2010:

- **Term II: May 29 - July 10, 2010** (6 weeks)
registration deadline: May 1, 2010
- **Term III: July 17 - August 14, 2010** (4 weeks)
registration deadline: June 19, 2010

→ Students applying before April 10 (Term II) / May 29 (Term III) will save 50 Euro off the Program Fee.
